6. The Central Office of Measures makes the following comment on notification 2023/0757/FR - C60A (labelling – informing consumers about the price of products that have undergone a downward change in quantity at unchanged or rising purchase prices):

Provision of Directive 98/6/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 February 1998 on consumer protection in the indication of the prices of products offered to consumers (OJ EU L 80, 4.7.1998) do not mention additional information such as weight reduction or price increase within three months.

According to the Central Office of Measures, such an additional provision in stores may result in greater consumer concerns.

The Act on Information on Prices of Goods and Services of 9 May 2014 (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 168) which implemented Directive 98/6/EC applies in this respect in Poland.
