

**REGULATION**

**on the rates of fee to pay the costs of handling waste from single-use plastic products<sup>2)</sup>**

Pursuant to Article 3l(2) of the Act on the Obligations of Entrepreneurs in the Field of Management of Certain Waste and on the Product Fee of 11 May 2001 (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 1903, and Journal of Laws of 2023, item 877) the following is hereby decreed:

§ 1. 1. The rate of the fee to pay the costs of collecting waste generated from single-use plastic products of the same type that the economic operator has placed on the market, left in public waste collection systems, including the fee to pay the costs of setting up and maintaining those systems, transporting and treating such waste, and to clean up, transport, and treat waste generated from single-use plastic products of the same type as the waste generated from single-use plastic products that the economic operator has placed on the market shall be:

- 1) PLN 0.10 per 1 kg of:
  - a) food containers,
  - b) packs and wrappers made of flexible materials containing food intended for direct consumption from the package or wrapper without any further processing,
  - c) beverage containers up to three litres,
  - d) drinking cups, including their covers and lids,

e) light plastic shopping bags within the meaning of Article 8(15a)(a) of the Act of 13 June 2013 on the Management of Packaging and Packaging Waste (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 1658 and 1852)

— referred to in Section I of Annex 9 to the Act on the Obligations of Entrepreneurs in the Field of Management of Certain Waste and on the Product Fee of 11 May 2001, hereinafter referred to as the ‘Act’;

2) PLN 0.01 per piece of tobacco products with filters containing plastics and of filters containing plastics, sold for use with tobacco products referred to in Section III of Annex 9 to the Act.

2. The rate of the fee to pay the costs of cleaning, transporting, and treating waste generated from single-use plastic products of the same type as the waste generated from single-use plastic products that the economic operator has placed on the market shall be PLN 0.01 per unit of:

- 1) wet wipes,
- 2) balloons, with the exception of balloons for industrial or other professional use, which are not distributed to consumers

— referred to in Section II of Annex 9 to the Act.

§ 2. The Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 2024.
