Within the framework of the notification procedure laid down by Directive (EU) 2015/1535(), the Polish authorities notified to the Commission on 4-10 February 2025 the draft methodologies for the integrated production of leeks (2025/68/PL), savoy cabbage (2025/69/PL), honeyberry (2025/70/PL), garden peas (2025/71/PL), field beans (2025/72/PL),



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root and leaf parsley (2025/74/PL), triticale (2025/75/PL), peppers (2025/76/PL), oats (2025/77/PL), chickpeas (2025/128/PL), lentils (2025/129/PL) and hazel (2025/0130/PL) (hereinafter referred to either collectively as 'the notified drafts' or individually as 'the draft notified under number [the respective notification number]').  
Below please find clarifications for the comments made during the notification process.

### 1. Openness of the scheme to producers from other Member States

In line with the Commission's suggestion, the methodologies no longer contain any provisions that could suggest that the system is not open to producers from other Member States.

Wordings causing ambiguity as to the availability of the scheme to producers from other countries Member States, i.e. references to the territory of Poland and national provisions, have been deleted from the IP methodologies.

The integrated plant production scheme is open to all producers.

### 2. Support under the CAP Strategic Plans

Polish authorities ensure that by endorsing the quality scheme based on the CAP strategic plan, they act pursuant to the provisions of Article 47(a)(i) and (ii) of the delegated Commission Regulation (EU) 2022/126 [Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/126 of 7 December 2021 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2021/2115 of the European Parliament and of the Council with additional requirements for certain types of intervention specified by Member States in their CAP Strategic Plans for the period 2023 to 2027 under that Regulation as well as rules on the ratio for the good agricultural and environmental condition (GAEC) standard 1, (OJ L 20, 31.1.2022, p. 52)]. Products produced according to integrated crop production methodologies significantly exceed the requirements of universally applicable law.

### 3. Accreditation of laboratories

The content of the methodologies has been revised to exclude possible non-compliance with the EU regulations on the performance of official examinations within the meaning of Regulation 2017/625.

### 4. Biocidal products and plant protection products

In the methodologies notified under numbers 2025/71/PL, 2025/74/PL and 2025/76/PL, the reference to the use of phosphates or sodium hypochlorite for washing and/or disinfection of sprayers has been deleted.

### 5. Reference to EU marketing standards for sweet peppers

In 'Methodology for the integrated pepper production (under shelter and in the field)', the wording concerning The marketing standards for sweet peppers has been deleted (2025/76/PL).

### 6. Food information to consumers

Polish authorities are aware of the fact that a quality mark must meet the requirements related to the characteristics of the product that go beyond the generally applicable law and that give superior quality to the products as compared with similar products. We confirm that the integrated plant production system meets these criteria.

Please also be informed that the comments sent by the Member State Spain have been taken into account.
