

**LAW AMENDING LAW NO VIII-787
ON WASTE MANAGEMENT
OF THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA**

Article 1 Amendment to Article 2

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3. Paragraph 28¹ is added to Article 2, as follows:

“28¹. European standard – a term as defined in Regulation (EU) No 1025/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on European standardisation, amending Council Directives 89/686/EEC and 93/15/EEC and European Parliament and Council Directives 94/9/EC, 94/25/EC, 95/16/EC, 97/23/EC, 98/34/EC, 2004/22/EC, 2007/23/EC, 2009/23/EC and 2009/105/EC and repealing Council Decision 87/95/EEC and European Parliament and Council Decision 1673/2006/EC.”

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Article 17 Amendment to Article 34¹

1. Part 27 of Article 34¹ is amended to read as follows:

“27. Waste from Electric and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) managers must collect WEEE separately, not mix it with other waste or materials and manage it according to waste management priorities and in a way that is safe for public health, using the best available techniques for the management of WEEE. WEEE managers must have and apply the relevant European standard(s) taking into account the ongoing WEEE management activities and the types of electrical and electronic equipment managed.”

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Article 41 Amendment to Article 34³¹

1. Part 1 of Article 34³¹ is amended to read as follows:

“1. The documents proving the management of product and/or packaging waste shall have the right to be issued by users (recyclers) of product and/or packaging waste, exporters of product and/or packaging waste; product and/or packaging waste collectors and/or waste managers treating the collected mixed municipal waste by separating product and/or packaging waste for recycling and/or other recovery which meet the requirements laid down in this Article and are entered, in accordance with the procedure laid down by the Government or an institution authorised by it, in the documents proving the management of product and/or packaging waste in the list of waste managers entitled to draw up the list of waste managers (hereinafter referred to in this Article as the List of Waste Managers). The requirement to be entered in the List of Waste Managers in accordance with the procedure established by the Government or an institution authorised by it shall not apply to waste electrical and electronic equipment managers who, taking into account the activities carried out in the management of waste electrical and electronic equipment and the types of electrical and electronic equipment being managed, have the relevant European standard(s) and the list of such managers shall be published in accordance with the procedure laid down by the Minister of Environment.

Users (recyclers) of product and/or packaging waste, exporters of product and/or packaging waste, collectors and/or waste managers of product and/or packaging waste treating the collected mixed municipal waste by separating product and/or packaging waste for the purpose of recycling and/or other recovery, issue documents proving the management of product and/or packaging waste in accordance with the procedure laid down by the Minister of Environment. Unauthorised issuing of documents proving the management of products and/or packaging waste shall be prohibited.”

2. Add part 9 in paragraph 2 of the Article 34³¹:

“9) the quantity of waste electrical and electronic equipment exported to a user of such waste who does not have a European standard for carrying out such activities.”
