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**GOVERNMENT REGULATION
of 17 April 2024**

**amending Government Regulation No 163/2002 laying down
technical requirements for selected construction products, as
amended**

**Pursuant to § 22(1) of Act No 22/1997 on technical requirements for products and
amending certain acts, as amended by Act No 205/2002, Act No 34/2011 and Act No
526/2020, (hereinafter the 'Act'), the Government orders the following to implement
§ 11a(2), § 12 and 13 of the Act:**

Article I

Government Regulation No 163/2002 laying down technical requirements for selected construction products, as amended by Government Regulation No 312/2005 and Government Regulation No 215/2016, is amended as follows:

1. In § 2(1), the last sentence is deleted.
2. In § 2 the following paragraphs (3) to (5) are added:
 - '(3) On the basis of conformity assessment, the manufacturer or importer shall issue a declaration of conformity pursuant to § 13 and affix the Czech conformity mark to the product; the manufacturer or importer does not need to affix the Czech conformity mark in the case of conformity assessment for unit production pursuant to § 9. The specimen of the Czech conformity mark is set out in Annex 4 to this Regulation.
 - (4) The Czech conformity mark must be affixed visibly, legibly and indelibly to the product. If this is not possible or justified due to the nature of the product, it shall be attached to the packaging or accompanying documentation.
 - (5) If the Czech conformity mark is enlarged or reduced, the proportions between its individual elements must be respected. The height of the Czech conformity mark must not be less than 10 mm.'
3. In § 13(1), a new subparagraph (f) is inserted after subparagraph (e) which reads:
 - 'f) a complete set of declared technical characteristics of the product that may affect at least one of the essential requirements for construction listed in Annex 1 to

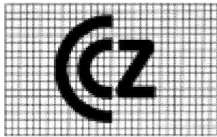
this Regulation; these characteristics shall be stated within the scope of the initial type test and shall be expressed in class, level, limit value or description in such a way that the structure can be properly designed and constructed;‘.

Subparagraphs (f)–(h) are renumbered subparagraphs (g)–(i).

4. In § 13(1)(h), the words ‘the characteristics of the product fulfil’ are replaced by the words ‘the product fulfils the declared characteristics of the product, fulfilling’ and the word ‘permanently’ is inserted after the word ‘which’.
5. In § 13a(1), the words ‘or other’ are replaced by ‘, other’ and the words ‘or in Turkey’ are inserted after the word ‘area’.
6. In § 13a(2), the words ‘and § 10’ are replaced by ‘, 10 and 13’.
7. Annex 4 is added, which, including its heading reads:

Article II

Transitional provisions

1. Products placed on the market before the effective date of this Regulation shall be subject to the legislation in effect at the time they are placed on the market.
2. Documents issued or acquired during conformity assessment prior to the effective date of this Regulation may be used for purposes of issuing a conformity assessment pursuant to Government Regulation No 163/2002, as amended as of the effective date of this Regulation.
3. A declaration of conformity for which the conformity assessment procedure was carried out pursuant to § 7 of Government Regulation No 163/2002, as amended before the effective date of this Regulation, issued prior to the effective date of this Regulation, shall remain valid for the period specified therein.
4. A declaration of conformity for which the conformity assessment procedure was carried out pursuant to §§ 5 to 6, 8 or 9 of Government Regulation No 163/2002,

as amended prior to the effective date of this Regulation, issued prior to the effective date of this Regulation, remains valid until there is a change in the circumstances under which the declaration of conformity was issued, but for no longer than 3 years after the effective date of this Regulation.

Article III

Final provisions

This Regulation has been notified in accordance with Directive (EU) 2015/1535 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 September 2015 laying down a procedure for the provision of information in the field of technical regulations and of rules on Information Society services.

Article IV

Effective date

This Regulation shall come into effect on 1 January 2025.
