6. The Czech Republic would like to thank for the information on the upcoming Latvian legislation 2024/0351/LV. However, the Czech Republic considers that the notified proposal to amend the Act on the handling of alcoholic beverages, if adopted as proposed, will not only create barriers to trade, but will introduce discriminatory treatment for the beer sector and a possible precedent in other EU markets.

We see the following provisions as the main points of concern in the draft:

- 1) The provisions concerning the mandatory nutrition declaration need to be clarified. The current draft is inconsistent because it states that the nutrition declaration can only be limited to the energy value, but still requires a complete nutrition declaration (the 'big 7'). Latvia should clarify whether the nutrition declaration has to be provided in full or can be limited to the energy value only (as currently allowed by FIC Regulation 1169/2011/EU).
- 2) The draft Act does not seem to comply with EU law when it states that, in addition to the mandatory list of ingredients, 'information on substances or products causing allergies or intolerances must be provided directly on the packaging or on an affixed label'. Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011 requires that the declaration of an allergen should not be repeated on the label if it is already included in the list of ingredients.
- 3) The draft text introduces discriminatory treatment between physical retail outlets and on-line sales of alcoholic beverages, as there must be a 6-hour delay between the sale and delivery of alcoholic beverages (if there is no delay between order and delivery in physical retail outlets). In addition to discrimination between types of companies, it further restricts the freedom and choice of consumers. This provision should be deleted from Latvia's draft.
