Within the framework of the notification procedure under Directive (EU) 2015/1535 (1), the Belgian authorities notified to the Commission on 21 August 2025 the “Draft decree by the Government of the Brussels-Capital Region amending their previous decree of 1 December 2016 on waste management and related provisions” (hereinafter, “the notified draft”).

According to the notification message, the notified draft regulates certain technical aspects relating to the management of battery waste by producers.

In order to allow the Commission services to complete their analysis under the relevant provisions of EU law, the Belgian authorities are kindly invited to reply to the following request for supplementary information.

1) The Belgian authorities are invited to clarify whether the notified draft would apply to providers of intermediary services, in particular but not only to online platforms, as defined in Regulation (EU) 2022/2065 (2). In the affirmative, the Commission services would welcome further information on:

- a) the concrete obligations for providers of online platforms as defined in Regulation (EU) 2022/2065 resulting from the notified draft, and in particular Subsection 15;
- b) the way in which providers of online platforms would be expected to comply with these obligations in a manner that would be compliant with Articles 6 and 8 of Regulation (EU) 2022/2065;
- c) the intended interplay between the notified draft and Regulation (EU) 2022/2065, in view of its maximum harmonization effect, notably, but not limited to, as regards the requirements of its Chapter III, Section 4, in particular Article 30;



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d) what system is envisaged for supervision of compliance and enforcement of the above obligations applicable to providers of online platforms, and in particular whether non-compliance would result in the imposition of fines or other types of sanctions or penalties, and the intended interplay with Chapter IV of Regulation (EU) 2022/2065.

2) The Belgian authorities are invited to clarify whether the notified draft under Subsection 9, § 8 is to be understood to oblige a producer to take back waste batteries from the respective category they made available on the market, or what “in accordance with legal obligations” refers to.

The Belgian authorities are kindly invited to reply by 26 September.
