8. The provisions promote overarching systems of technical youth media protection. In this way, the existing youth protection measures should be made more usable and linked in such a way that they can develop their effectiveness in the best possible way. The provisions oblige providers of operating systems as a central setting level to provide an easily accessible youth protection tool through which end devices used by children and adolescents can be adjusted appropriately. The provisions of the draft also concern alignments with the Youth Protection Act and include, for example, requirements for the labelling of development-impairing telemedia. The system of regulated self-regulation will be strengthened with the new provisions.

9. The provision serves the further development of youth media protection in view of regulatory practice, especially at a technical level. Setting options for the youth media protection of end devices are often difficult to find, not sufficiently linked to each other and are often not used as a result, so that they cannot exploit their protection potential. For example, the 2022 KIM study notes that almost 70 % of parents do not make any technical settings on the devices used by their children. At the same time, children use the Internet unaccompanied earlier and have their own end device earlier.

The aim of the new provisions is to provide children and young people with age-appropriate access to the wide range of services offered by the Internet so that they can use and learn the possibilities of the Internet as comprehensively as possible and at the same time be protected.
