6. Within the framework of Directive 2015/1535, on 18 March 2025, the Norwegian Government notified its draft 'Regulation prohibiting the sale of energy drinks to children under 16 years of age'.

Examination of the draft has led the Spanish authorities to issue the comments set out below pursuant to Article 5(2) of the aforementioned Directive.

Spain requests the following of the Norwegian authorities:

- 1. that they clarify why the draft establishes a definition of energy drink, including the minimum caffeine content that must be included in its composition, given that there is no harmonised definition in European Union legislation and that other Member States of the European Union have national legislation that establishes definitions with different composition criteria to those formulated in the draft for this type of product;
- 2. on the basis of the above, it being noted that the draft does not include a mutual recognition clause, the Norwegian authorities are urged to introduce such a clause to prevent this regulation from becoming an unnecessary obstacle to intra-Union trade in the foods covered by the draft.
