8. The Ordinance regulates the salvaging and use of excavated materials resulting from excavation activities and the end of waste for certain excavated materials.

9. In Austria, excavated materials are largely sent to landfills, despite some materials being technically suitable for recycling. The aim of the Ordinance is to channel uncontaminated excavated materials into preparation for re-use and recycling of the highest possible quality.
