AFAÏA comments about the notification 2016/393

We question this project, about § 2 f) item 7 (Enzymatic hydrolysate of Fabaceae):

A specific category, to allow hydrolysates <u>from animal origin</u> has been recently added in the Regulation EC 889/2008 (annex I). Of course, hydrolysates from Fabaceae, cannot benefit of this amendment. And in most of EU member states, such hydrolysates are even not considered as "Products and by-products of plant origin for fertilisers" (ref. EC 889/2008, annexe I).

So, at EU level, <u>enzymatic hydrolysates of Fabaceae are generally not permitted in</u> <u>organic farming</u>. Then we consider that their acceptance by Italy will generate <u>an unfair</u> <u>competition</u> with the other EU member states.
