# REGULATION amending, for the seventh time, Building Regulation No 112/2012

### Article 1

The words "and have neither electrical wiring nor water plumbing" in Article 1.2.1, point 77, of the regulation are deleted.

## Article 2

Article 3.8.2, point A, reads as follows: Confirmation from the master electrician that the electrical installations of that part of the structure which is being taken into use is ready for inspection.

### Article 3

Article 3.9.2, point A, of the regulation reads as follows: Confirmation from the master electrician regarding the electrical installations of the structure being ready for inspection.

#### Article 4

A new paragraph is inserted after Article 6.7.1, paragraph 10, of the regulation, as follows: New and restored buildings shall contain connecting devices for charging electric cars at every parking space.

#### Article 5

Two new paragraphs are added to Article 6.8.1 of the regulation:

The number of parking spaces where electric cars can be charged shall be given in the design documentation during the design of such buildings and their restoration.

The Iceland Construction Authority shall issue guidelines on the implementation of this Article.

#### Article 6

Article 8.3.1 of the regulation reads as follows: Cement, concrete and concrete structures shall comply with the provisions of the Act on Construction Products, of the Icelandic standards for construction design, see Article 8.2.1, and the following standards: IST EN 197-1, IST EN 12620, IST EN 206 and IST EN 13670.

#### Article 7

Article 14.7.1, paragraph 5, of the regulation shall read as follows: The design of electrical wiring in family houses shall be based on the IST 150 and IST 151 standards.

#### Article 8

In Article 14.11.2, paragraph 2, of the regulation the words "Regulation on passenger lifts and passenger and service lifts" are replaced by "Regulation on lifts and safety components for lifts".

## Article 9

This regulation, laid down pursuant to Article 60, paragraph 1, of the Construction Act No 160/2010 shall enter into force forthwith.
