5. Draft regulation of the Minister for Digitisation on the technical and operational requirements for digital receivers

6. Digital receivers of digital terrestrial television broadcasting

8. The draft Regulation lays down the technical and operational requirements for digital receivers of digital terrestrial television broadcasting.

The draft Regulation is issued on the basis of the statutory authorisation under Article 132(3) of the Telecommunications Act of 16 July 2004 (Journal of Laws [Dziennik Ustaw] 2018, item 1954, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the 'Act', in accordance with which the Minister responsible for computerisation shall determine, by way of a regulation, the

technical and operational requirements for digital receivers, bearing in mind the need to ensure their compatibility and accessibility for disabled persons.

9. In the face of continuous technological development and the expected launch of new DVB-T2 television standards, it is appropriate to adjust current requirements for digital receivers accordingly in line with the provisions of the Regulation of the Minister for Administration and Digitisation of 7 July 2015 on technical and operational requirements for digital receivers (Journal of Laws 2017, item 1092).

The draft Regulation lays down technical and operational requirements related to the adjustment of receivers to the parameters required for DVB-T and DVB-T2 broadcasting, taking into account the adoption by the European Parliament and the Council Decision (EU) 2017/899 of 17 May 2017 on the use of the 470-790 MHz ('700 MHz') frequency band in the Union by 30 June 2020. The shift from the 700 MHz television band to 5G systems will make it impossible to develop television programming in the remaining radio spectrum resources based on the current DVB-T standard. Therefore, it is appropriate to introduce the more efficient DVB-T2/HEVC standard and change the intended use of the 700 MHz band in Poland.
