Within the framework of the notification procedure laid down in Directive (EU) 2015/1535, the Spanish authorities notified to the Commission on 23 September 2024 the draft 'Draft Organic Law for the Protection of Minors in Digital Environments' (hereinafter, the 'notified draft'). On 17 December 2024, the Commission issued a detailed opinion with comments to which the Spanish authorities replied on 27 February 2025. Pursuant to Article 6 (2) of Directive (EU) 2015/1535, the Member State concerned should report to the Commission on the action it proposes to take on such detailed opinions. The Commission should comment on this reaction. The Commission considers the response of the Spanish Authorities satisfactory.

The Commission services would like to thank the Spanish authorities for their reply and take note of the proposed amended draft law and would like to remind the Spanish authorities that any future regulatory development of the ban on access to random reward mechanisms that may be adopted by the Government to establish relevant technical provisions to allow age verification should be notified pursuant to Article 5 of the Single Market Transparency Directive.
