Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 November 2009 on cosmetic products;

Having regard to Directive (EU) 2015/1535 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 September 2015 laying down a procedure for the provision of information in the field of technical regulations and of rules on Information Society services (codification);

Having regard to notification XXXXX to the European Commission;

Having regard to the Public Health Code, in particular Article L. 5131-8 thereof;

Having regard to the opinion of the National Consumer Council, issued on 24 November 2021;

Having heard the Council of State (social section),

## Hereby decrees:

# Article 1

The Public Health Code shall be amended as follows:

II of Article R. 5131-4 is replaced by the following:

'At the moment of sale of any cosmetic product without pre-packaging, or which is packaged at the point of sale at the request of the buyer or pre-packaged for immediate sale, the information referred to in Article 19(1) of that Regulation shall be brought to the attention of the purchaser by any visible and legible means, in compliance with the provisions laid down in that Article. This information shall be made available on the product or in the immediate vicinity, indicating the product concerned. In addition, it can be made available by electronic means.'

#### Article 2

This Decree shall enter into force within six months of its publication.

## Article 3

The Prime Minister, the Minister for the Economy, Finance and Industrial and Digital Sovereignty and the Minister for Health and Prevention are each responsible, insofar as they are concerned, for the application of this Ordinance, which shall be published in the *Official Journal* of the French Republic.
