

Order of 5 February 2024 amending the Order of 14 December 2023 laying down the list of versions of electric passenger cars that have achieved the minimum environmental score required to be eligible for certain grants for the purchase or leasing of low-emission vehicles

Relevant audiences purchasers and lessees of vehicles; automotive professionals.

Subject: update of the list of versions of electric passenger cars that have achieved the minimum environmental score referred to in Article D. 251-1 of the Energy Code, laid down by the Order of 14 December 2023, and are therefore eligible for the ecological bonus for new passenger cars under this criterion.

Entry into force: this Order shall enter into force on the day after its publication.

Notice: this Order updates the list of versions of electric passenger cars that have achieved the minimum environmental score referred to in Article D. 251-1 of the Energy Code, laid down by the Order of 14 December 2023, after examination by the Environment and Energy Management Agency of a dossier submitted by their manufacturer. This is one of the conditions of eligibility for the ecological bonus for new passenger cars, linked to the environmental and climate impact of the production and delivery of the vehicle. This list details:

- the type, variant and version (TVV) associated with the version that has achieved the minimum environmental score;
- the make of the vehicle version in question;
- the model of the vehicle version in question.

Having regard to notification No 2024/056/FR sent on 5 February 2024 to the European Commission,

Hereby order the following:
