6. Sweden thanks Estonia for the question concerning the Swedish notification of the Ordinance amending the Ordinance on certain greenhouse gas emissions.

The Swedish implementation of ETS 2 and the unilateral extension to additional sectors under Article 30j of Directive 2003/87/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 October 2003 establishing a scheme for greenhouse gas emission allowance trading within the Community and amending Council Directive 96/61/EC (ETS Directive) are not considered to entail any additional monitoring and reporting requirements for recreational boaters. The proposed legislative amendments mean that the requirements for monitoring and reporting emissions under ETS 2 apply to operators requiring a permit who make fuel products available for consumption and not to those who burn the fuel. Operators subject to permit requirements under the Ordinance (2020:1180) on certain greenhouse gas emissions are required to monitor and report emissions under Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/2066 of 19 December 2018 on the monitoring and reporting of greenhouse gas emissions pursuant to Directive 2003/87/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council and amending Commission Regulation (EU) No 601/2012 (the 'Monitoring and Reporting Regulation').
