On 18 November 2024, as part of the procedure provided for in Directive (EU) 2015/1535, the French authorities notified the draft decree on digital travel assistance services adopted pursuant to Article L. 1214-8-3 of the Transport Code. On 25 November 2024, the European Commission sent the French authorities a request for additional information. The French authorities sent their responses on 12 December 2024. On 17 February 2025, the Commission issued a detailed opinion on this notified project (C(2025) 1183).

The French authorities hereby inform the Commission that the notified draft is to be adapted in the light of the detailed opinion of 17 February 2025: a new paragraph will specify that its scope is limited to digital travel assistance service providers established in France or outside the European Union (see the revised draft attached to this answer). Under these conditions, the French authorities consider that the revised draft decree complies with directive 2000/31/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2000 on certain legal aspects of information society services, in particular electronic commerce, in the Internal Market ('directive on electronic commerce').
